

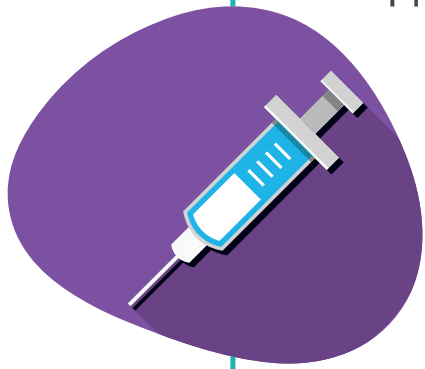


How to prevent genital warts and 9 different cancers

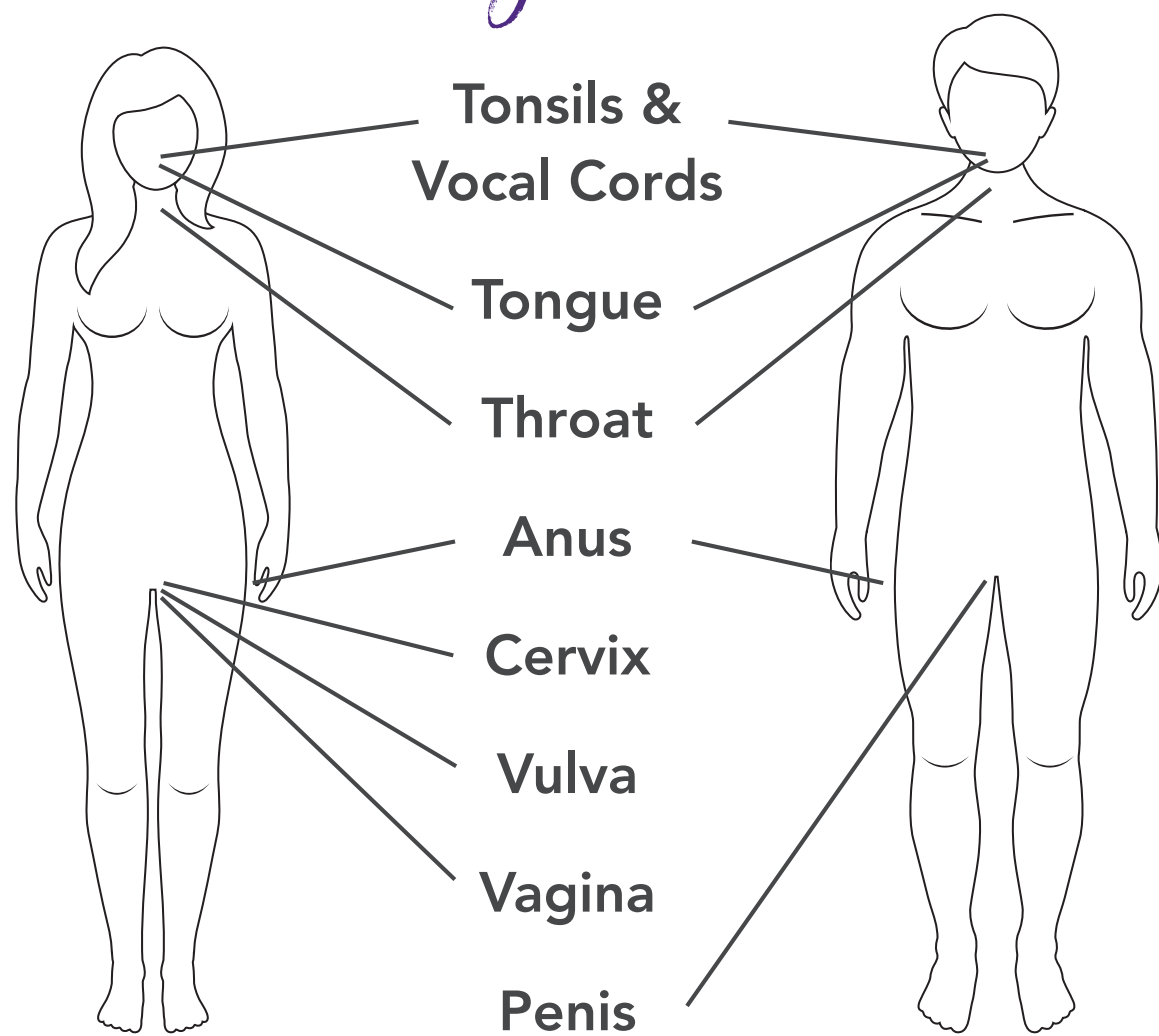
Did you know?

HPV causes 9 different types of cancers and genital warts. HPV vaccination is the best protection from this virus.

There are benefits for people of all ages. The vaccine protects people from being affected by different types of the virus with which they have not already come into contact with. If a person has cleared an HPV-related infection (genital warts or an HPV-related pre-cancer), the vaccine will help against reinfection. Furthermore, if you have a cervix, getting routine screening, whether vaccinated or not, can help detect cervical cancer earlier.

Are you sure you don't have HPV?

People come into contact with HPV, through any skin to skin sexual contact below the waistline with fingers, mouths or other body parts, even without penetration. Condoms do not fully protect people from this virus because there is still direct skin to skin contact.

Important steps

to prevent HPV cancers & genital warts

- ✓ I will look into getting the **HPV vaccine** no matter my age, gender, or relationship status.
- ✓ If I have a **cervix**, I need to get screened.
- ✓ I will **talk to my loved ones** about getting the HPV vaccine and getting screened.
